

Terms & Conditions for Data Science & Machine Learning Bootcamp

For the purposes of these T&Cs, wherever the context so requires “you” or “your” shall mean any natural person/learner/customer who enrolls or participates in this Program.

You agree that, by enrolling/ participating in this Program, you will be bound by these T&Cs, and you acknowledge that you have read and understood these T&Cs and you satisfy the Program eligibility requirements as provided herein below.

To the extent the intellipa.com Terms and Conditions, Terms of Use and Privacy Policy are inconsistent with these T&Cs, these T&Cs will prevail with respect to This Program only.

- 1.5. You have a valid document for identification;
- 1.6. You must provide valid Photo Identification and Address Proof.

Note: If you are in the final year of college and have not completed graduation, you must have at least 50% marks at the end of your graduation.

2. ADMISSION PROCESS

You undertake to adhere to the admission process for the Programme as provided below:

- 2.1. You agree to register for this Programme on www.intellipaat.com website by providing your details.
- 2.2. You shall submit an application with details pertaining to yourself and the reasons for joining the Programme.
- 2.3. You must meet the Eligibility criteria set for the Programme.
- 2.4. Based on the discussion and understanding of your candidature by the course advisory team, you will be offered admission to this Programme.
- 2.5. You shall complete the formalities to confirm your enrolment in the Programme by paying the Programme Fee as mentioned on the website or with the course advisor within the specified time period.

Placement opportunities will be provided if you are selected in the placement pool.
- 3.5. You are open to pan-India movement for the job.

 - 8.2. **Amicable Settlement:** If any dispute arises between you and Intellipaate hereto in connection with the validity, interpretation, implementation, or alleged material breach of any provision of these Terms and Conditions or regarding a question, you and Intellipaate shall endeavour to settle such dispute amicably. If the Parties fail to bring about an amicable settlement within a period of thirty (30) days, either Party to the dispute may give ten (10) days' notice of invocation of the arbitration provisions contained herein, to the other Party in writing.
 - 8.3. **Arbitration:** In the case of such failure, the dispute shall be referred to a sole arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. The seat and venue of the arbitration shall be Bangalore, Karnataka. The Arbitration proceeding shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, amended from time to time, and shall be conducted at the Bangalore Arbitration Centre. The costs of the arbitration procedure shall be borne equally by the Parties. The Parties

hereto shall submit to the Arbitrator's award and the award shall be enforceable in any competent court of law.

9. Discipline and Decorum

9.1. Online Sessions: You must obey the norms of discipline during online classes and tutorials.
